

MotionWeaver Setup Guide

~ Enabling Motion Translation from Anywhere ~

[!NOTE] **Regarding Operation on Mac Environments (For Advanced Users)** The core of this system, MotionWeaver (Python engine), is designed to be cross-platform and can theoretically be executed from the terminal in a Mac environment. However, because this tool is developed and tested primarily for Windows, we do not provide official support for Mac-specific Python environment setups or individual troubleshooting. Please install and use it in a Mac environment at your own risk (self-resolution via community).

1. Folder Placement

Move the downloaded folder to an easy-to-manage location on your PC (e.g., `C:\Tools\MotionWeaver`).

2. [IMPORTANT] Environment Variable (PATH) Setup

1. Press the Windows key, search for "Environment Variables," and open "**Edit the system environment variables.**"
2. Click the "Environment Variables" button.
3. Under "User variables," select **Path** and click "Edit."
4. Click "New," paste the **folder path** where `MotionWeaver.exe` is located, and close everything with "OK."

3. Verification

Open the Command Prompt (cmd), type `MotionWeaver --help`, and press Enter.

If the help text is displayed, it is successful. This means you can call it at any time from commands or external tools (like BatchWeaver).
